



To: Non-Profit Service Clubs for MATO Food Court

The Caballeros de Yuma invites your organization to again be a food concessionaire for the 34th Annual MIDNIGHT AT THE OASIS FESTIVAL, March 5 - 7, 2027. All food concessions will again be handled by community non-profit organizations and service clubs. **Completed application, including payment and certificate of insurance must be received no later than Friday, February 12, 2027.** Please submit a list of "ALL FOODS" you would like to serve for approval. In this process, we can be certain of the variety that will available to the public.

Each club will be responsible for checking with the Health Department about permits and code requirements. Any Temporary Food Service Applications and Permit Fees are the responsibility of the food concessionaire and must be **obtained in advance of the event.** Failure to obtain a permit before operation may result in exclusion of this event. The Temporary Food Service Permit must be visibly posted inside the concession booth. **All food vendors will be REQUIRED to attend a meeting with the Health Food Department to be scheduled, date TBA. If you are unable to attend, a representative from your group will need to attend. This will give us time to answer any questions about setup, cleanup and expectations for the 2026 event.**

The festival will again open up to the general public at Noon on Friday, March 6th. With that being said, all food vendors will be required to set up their location on Thursday, March 5th. All Food Booths will be required to be open and operating during the entire duration of the event. All trucks, trailers, etc. will be required to be off the food court premises no later than 9:00 am on Friday, March 7th. If you feel this request cannot be managed by your group, please let us know as soon as possible so we have the opportunity to fill your location with another food vendor from our waiting list.

The FOOD COURT will remain in the same area, to the right of the Main Gate. The COOKING AREA can be accessed on the east end of the Food Court. The Caballeros will set up tables and chairs for public use. DO NOT DUMP cooking oils and/or byproducts into the event garbage cans or dumpsters at Ray Kroc Complex. It is the responsibility of each food concessionaire to transport & dispose of cooking oils and/or byproducts off the property, as well as to LEAVE YOUR AREA CLEAN. A \$500 fine will be imposed for those who do not follow procedures.

The food concessionaire fee for the weekend is \$1,250.00 for each 20 x 20 space. This fee includes required white tent from Reddy Rents and 50amp of electricity. Your vendor fee also helps cover the cost of power, clean up, tables & chairs. Additional electrical boxes are available for an extra fee. All booth assignments and/or locations are subject to change due to changing food court conditions/requirements at any time. **Please make check payable to the Caballeros de Yuma.** A certificate of insurance with a \$1 million per occurrence/\$2 million aggregate minimum liability, must accompany your application showing the CABALLEROS de YUMA, INC., as additionally insured.

Your organization will receive the same number of daily passes as last year. Should you need any additional passes, you will need to be purchase them from the Caballeros de Yuma office prior to the event. If you elect not to purchase additional tickets prior to the festival, you will be required to pay the gate price upon arrival. Passes may be picked up by February 13, 2026 at the Caballeros de Yuma office.

MIDNIGHT AT THE OASIS is a great fund raising activity for your organization. **IF YOU CANNOT PARTICIPATE AT MATO 2027, PLEASE LET US KNOW ASAP,** so that another organization on the waiting list can participate. You may wish to provide additional lighting for your area. **Additional electrical boxes are available for purchase. Please indicate if additional electrical boxes are needed. \$ 250 (Additional 50 Amps) YES NO**

SET UP/CLEAN UP: MUST SET UP Thursday, March 4th, between 10 am & 6 pm. NO vehicles will be allowed into Stadium after 8:00 am on Friday, March 5, 2026. Tables and chairs are **NOT** provided for your booths.

DO NOT DUMP cooking oils or hot coals into the garbage cans or dumpsters at Ray Kroc Complex. It is the responsibility of each food concessionaire to transport & dispose of oils &/or byproducts off the property. **LEAVE YOUR AREA CLEAN AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE EVENT. There will be a \$500 fine/charge for clean-up services.**

HOURS: Any food concessionaire booths closing early and/or not showing up during all hours of operation will result in a \$500 fine on the first offense and not invited back to attend on the second offense.

Hours of Operation: **Friday, March 5, 2027 - 12:00 Noon to 11:00 pm**
 Saturday, March 6, 2027 - 9:00 am to 11:30 pm
 Sunday, March 7, 2027 - 9:00 am to 1:00 pm

INSURANCE: Certificate of Insurance is required, \$1 million minimum per occurrence, \$100,000 property damage and general aggregate of \$2 million liability naming the Caballeros de Yuma, Inc. as additional insured.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY/INDEMNITY AGREEMENT: In consideration of the acceptance of the right to participate in the Midnight at the Oasis Festival, vendors, concessionaires and spectators by execution of this form, release and discharge Midnight at the Oasis Festival, the Caballeros de Yuma, Inc., and their officers, directors, trustees, members, employees, agents, representatives, volunteers and servants and anyone else connected with the management or presentation of Midnight at the Oasis Festival of and from any and all known and unknown damages, injuries, losses, judgments and/or claims from any cause whatsoever that may be suffered by applicant to his person or property. Further, each applicant expressly agrees to indemnify all the foregoing entities, firms and persons from any and all liability occasioned or cooperating with the applicant and under the direction or control of the applicant. Applicant agrees that participation in any contest, games or activities may be limited. No pets/animals or firearms permitted. Applicant must be 18 years of age. I have read and agreed to all conditions of the Midnight at the Oasis Festival application and agree to observe all rules and decisions of the event management.
